2. Be an international student (on a non-immigrant visa) enrolled in a class at MSU.
3. Indicate evidence of financial need.
4. Provide evidence of academic excellence.
5. Complete ALL questions on the application form.
6. Be able to appear in person for an interview.
7. Provide Academic Advisor's name and contact information.

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

Fall Semester: July 15

Spring Semester: November 15

*All requirements must be met before the application is considered for a scholarship. Unmarried students do not qualify. Consideration will emphasize financial need and academic excellence. Applicants will be notified as to status and an interview will be scheduled if eligible.
